Halloween Chess Set Instructions - Mummies

Materials:

Low temp glue gun

White craft glue

White fun foam

Tan fun foam

Seminole green paint

Glow green paint

2 - square toothpicks or craft sticks, cut to 1 1/4" lengths

1" gauze

 $2 - 1 \frac{1}{4}$ " doll head knobs

2 - 7/8" Candle cups (1 3/4" tall)

2 – 7mm orange pompoms

4 - 10mm round wiggle eyes

2 - bases: 1 3/4" wooden circles (1/4" thick)

For each Mummy (make 2 for a chess set):

- 1- Using craft glue, glue the flat side of the doll head to the bottom of the candle cup.
- 2- Paint the base seminole green, and the mummy's head and body glow green. Spray both pieces with a clear matt fixative.
- 3- Cut out the Mummy's feet and arms on white fun foam using the patterns provided. Draw on the bandage lines as shown.
- 4- Using craft glue, glue the feet onto the base, lining up the toes with the front edge of the base.
- 5- Using craft glue or a low temp glue gun, glue the mummy to the round part of the foam feet, so that the feet stick out the front, and the round part of the foam is basically lined up under the body.
- 6- Glue the eyes and nose in place using craft glue.
- 7- Wrap the mummy in 1 inch gauze so that only it's face is showing. Overlap the layers a bit for best results. Glue both ends down with craft glue.
- 8- Glue the arms in place using a low temp glue gun.
- 9- Cut out the sign from tan fun foam, and print the following on the sign, using a fine tip sharpie:

I want my Mummy

- 10- Glue the 1 ¼ inch toothpick or square craft stick to the back of the sign, making sure that the extra length is hanging off the bottom side of the sign to create the handle.
- 11- Wrap either fun foam "hand" of the mummy around the toothpick handle and glue into place using a low temp glue gun.

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
